





Burnsville Lake marina is located at the Riffle Run Day Use Area directly behind the dam. The dock area provides visitors with docking facilities, boat rentals, snack bar, and an array of fishing supplies.



outdoor fun

canoeing & kayaking

Come out and enjoy a float on the Elk! **The Elk River Water Trail** makes the Elk River more accessible from the Sutton Lake tail waters to its confluence with the Kanawha River in Charleston.

The Elk is the longest river located entirely within the border of West Virginia and is the centerpiece of fishing in the state because of its geographical location. A canoe or kayak trip down the Elk offers a great day's recreation for everyone.

boating

Both of our lakes have marinas and boat launch ramps for boating enthusiasts and fishermen. The docking facilities offer food and snacks, boat rentals, and fishing supplies. For those who want a little more speed, it's the perfect place for jet skis or a day of water skiing, (but please pay strict attention to our boating rules, no wake zones, and speed limits. We want everyone to enjoy their day). Sutton Lake Marina offers paddleboats, pontoon boats and luxury houseboats for rent.



swimming

Instead of choosing between the beach or the mountains, why not do both? Beautiful, sandy and free swimming beaches can be found at both Sutton and Burnsville Lakes. The lake facilities include restrooms, change booths, and outside showers.

hiking & biking

Whether you like biking or hiking, we have a trail that will fit your skill level. Choose from challenging hiking on the Jeremiah Carpenter Trail, to a family biking excursion on old county dirt roads with multiple creek crossings and swimming holes. Bulltown historic area


To get an idea of how people lived here when Braxton County was first settled, the Bulltown Historic Area helps history come alive. The area includes a visitors center with exhibits showing how people lived in the mid to late 1800's. There are also structures from that time, as well as a Civil War battlefield and fortification site. A mile-long trail leads you by remnants of union trenches, the Cunningham Farm, sites of many other fascinating spots, including a portion of the Weston-Gauley Bridge Turnpike, The McCauley Barn, St. Michael's Church and more. Tours of the area may be arranged through the visitors center, or you can take a self-guided tour.

Bulltown is located on US 19/4, 10 miles north of I-79, Flatwoods Exit 67 or take I-79, Exit 79 at Burnsville, Route 5 west to Heaters, take a left and travel Rt. 19 N to Bulltown.

Civil War Trail

Sutton's location on the Weston and Gauley Bridge Turnpike (one of the better roads in the area) made it and others nearby strategically important to both Union and Confederate armies. Trail signs are located at the Courthouse in Sutton and at the Bulltown Historic Area, located near the Burnsville Dam and Lake.



history and heritage

In Braxton County, we celebrate our heritage with joy... from our pre-Civil War past, to our role in the “war between the states,” to our antiques, arts & crafts, and restoration of many our historic buildings and sites.

two hundred years of history

Braxton County was formed by the Virginia Legislature in 1836, carved from the surrounding counties - Kanawha, Nicholas, and Lewis - and named for Carter Braxton, a Virginia statesman and signer of the Declaration of Independence.


The first permanent white settlers were the four Carpenter brothers and their mother, who arrived some time around 1789. About 1810, John D. Sutton took up residence in what was then Newville. It later became Suttonville, and was finally changed to Sutton in 1837. It was then, and is now, the county seat.

In 1861, most of downtown Sutton was burned by Confederate soldiers. In 1863, The Battle of Bulltown took place near the Union trenches, lasting about 12 hours. (The Battle of Bulltown Re-enactment is held every other year and is very popular with visitors and Civil War buffs).


Sutton and surrounding areas rebuilt after the Civil War, becoming a commercial center when the timber industry developed. Many of the historic buildings in Sutton date from the period of 1890-1920.

take a walk through history

If historic places make you feel at home, you'll love it here! We have many sites on the National Register of Historic Places - including the Sutton Historic District downtown. In addition, the area offers many restored buildings that are historically and visually wonderful. The Landmark Theater is a restored Victorian era church. Cafe Cimino Country Inn offers elegant dining and accommodations in a beautiful Colonial Revival mansion at the end of town on the Elk River. You can take a walking tour of the Sutton Historic District and enjoy wonderful examples of late 1800's - early 1900's architecture. Be sure to visit Gassaway, with its historic Train Depot, wonderful old churches, and thriving retail shops on Elk Street.

Historic Downtown Main Street Shopping

Head for downtown Sutton or Gassaway, and enjoy shopping surrounded by history, places for lunch, friendly people and a relaxing atmosphere.

The quaint little Town of Sutton, at I-79 Exit 62, is the County Seat for Braxton. It is home to Sutton Dam, Sutton Lake, an artsy downtown historic district, and the newly designated Elk River Water Trail, which begins there and continues all the way to the state's capitol of Charleston, some 98 miles of scenic canoe and kayak water.



Visitors to Sutton enjoy strolling down the 6 blocks of Main Street, filled with rich examples of early 1900's architecture. This town hosts the Sutton Artz Walk where you can visit shops, galleries and



theaters featuring local art. You are guided on the Artz Walk by the colorful purple stars painted on the sidewalk in front of each of the following Artz Walk partners: Elk



Theater, Hometown Events and Country Charms, Poplar Forest, The Needle Basket, Artisans at P.J.Berry's, Landmark Studio for the Arts, and MountainMade


